“A Figure of Eight at Armathwaite “

Grade Moderate

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw.

Good parking is available in the village of Armathwaite at NY 506/461. This trail could be followed either way, but working on the Wainwright principal of up hills first, we chose to do this trail this way round. As we leave the village we ascend the rise past the railway station, use a little used track passing through a busy farmyard, return under a viaduct, include a stroll on the banks of the Eden, and pass two pubs. We enjoyed an afternoon stroll with great views towards the distant fells, but enjoyed the softness of the Eden Valley, what better way to finish a trail in the countryside than a pint in a country pub?

Total Distance: 6.5km with 172m of ascent all on good paths with just one slightly boggy section near the farm... Allow Two and a half hours.

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour
