“Austwick in the Dales “

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw, held every month.

This trail commences at the school in Austwick G/R SD 7688/6863, winds its way past two lovely hamlets, often on ancient paths, passing over several pretty becks before returning across fields to the village. Use O/S Explorer Map OL2 Yorkshire Dales Southern and Western Areas This is a delightful walk on good paths with a superb picnic site at Waypoint 8. Refreshments are available in the village of Austwick; allow Three to Three and a Half hours including stops

Total Distance: 8.6KM (5.4 Miles) Height Gain: 267M (877 Feet)

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
