Would you like “Go Geocaching” – find out what this growing sport of Geocaching is all about? Then this trail could be for you, we have even arranged for some loan GPS to be available at the YHA if required. This trail is achievable by almost everyone, and uses mostly good paths or tracks, and starts at the YHA NY 255/142.

From the Hostel we wander through the fields as we make our way to the picturesque hamlet of Stonethwaite, where we cross the beck and join a section of the Cumbria Way on our way to Rosthwaite before returning to the Hostel, the trail has a total distance of just over 3.5km and virtually no ascent. As an added bonus you always get the feeling in Borrowdale that you are at the heart of things, the high fells are all almost within touching distance.

**Using a GPS on a Geotrail**

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
