“Brougham Castle & Riverside walk “

Grade Easy with interest

Good parking is available in the road at NY 538 290. This trail is almost a trip through time, the first place of interest we pass is Brougham Castle the favourite home of Lady Anne Clifford an imposing ruin now maintained by English Heritage and well worth a visit if you have the time (climb up into the battlements for a bird's eye view of the site). As we make our way to Brougham Hall just past the castle you will see in the adjacent field the remains of a Roman legionary fort, an important holding position on the route to Hadrian's Wall. The Hall itself is 13th Century and steeped in history, now used by several arts and craft type businesses and importantly in the season a tea rooms. Moving on, beside the busy A6 we find more evidence of the importance of the area through the ages a prehistoric monument spend a few moments here and explore before we return to the castle using a delightful riverside walk.

Total Distance: 4km virtually no ascent. Allow 2 hours to investigate all the antiquities on offer.

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour
