This walk starts in the Lake District National Park car park (NY 323 398) and is the start of our exploration of this interesting village on the edge of the northern fells. On the trail you go through the wonderful Howk gorge with its fairy kettle and the remains of the bobbin mill, and then around the village itself. The whole area is famous for its variety of mills, its past mining history, and its connections with famous people like John Peel. There are cafes and the Oddfellows Arms for refreshment, craft shops, and the church to explore making this an ideal place to come for a relaxing afternoon stroll.

Allow an hour or so to give time to wander –virtually no ascent.

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour
