“Clapham – Yorkshire Dales “

Grade Moderate

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw, held every month.

This trail commences in the National Park Car Park in Clapham Village G/R SD 7455/6921. This lovely village is well worth exploring and good refreshments are served in several establishments. Use O/S Explorer Map OL2 Yorkshire Dales and Western Areas. This is a lovely undulating walk on good tracks or paths, with the exception of a short section about 240 metres after waypoint 8. Care should be taken here as a short part of the path runs close to the edge of small escarpment. On route there are wonderful views of Ingleborough and Pen-y-ghent and you will pass through interesting and geologically renowned rock fields before returning to the village. Good picnic areas are to be found near waypoint 3 and between waypoints 8 and 9. Allow a leisurely four hours to admire the views

Total Distance: 10.7KM (6.7 Miles) Height Gain: 367M (1203 Feet)

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
