“Ennerdale Water and Anglers Crag “

Grade Moderate but longish

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw, held every month.

Good parking is to be found at GR NY 085/153 not far from the Village of Ennerdale Bridge. Our trail makes a complete circuit of Ennerdale Water, visits Anglers Crag where you will have unrivalled views over Ennerdale and if the weather is kind to you great views of the Buttermere Fells and the Pillar massif. Descending to the lake shore we cross the River Liza on our return. The Trail leads you on a short diversion using the Smithy's Beck trail (follow the red posts) take the opportunity to visit the waterfall as you pass.

As we return to base there is a great picnic spot, and unexpectedly the site of the old Anglers Hotel, with a total distance 12.5 km approx 285m of ascent and descent this trail is a day well spent exploring one of Lakeland's lesser known areas, choose a clear day to get the best views of the high fells..

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour
