“Glencoynedale and Greenside Mines “

Grade Moderate

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw, held every month.

Park anywhere in Glenridding to access this trail which follows the lakeshore and then enters the peace and quiet of Glencoynedale, passes the old miners cottages at Seldom Seen, and rises to Nick Head where we advise you to stop, rest and take in the panoramic views over Helvellyn and Raise. We descend by Sticks Pass and the industrial remains of Greenside Mines on our return to the Village.

We recommend you allow 4 Hours on this trail that offers unparalleled views of Helvellyn and its neighbouring Fells, and allows you to visit a site of scientific importance on your return. The paths are mainly good throughout, Don't be afraid to take time to explore your mining heritage as you pass through.
Total Distance 9.45 KM and a Total Height Gain of 481M

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
