**“Gairloch to South Laggan Lock “**

**Grade Moderate but long**

This section of the Great Glen Way is full of interest, steeped in history, and a great day out, with stunning views down the loch, and over the Ben Nevis range. We follow the GGW until we arrive at the gates of Achnacarry, where we divert via the Clan Cameron Museum, Loch Arkaig and the Dark Mile (made famous during the search for Bonny Prince Charlie) before returning to the shores of Loch Lochy and on to Kilfinnan, be sure to visit the churchyard reached through Kilfinnan Farm, where you will find an interesting mausoleum raised in memory of the clan chiefs. At your destination South Laggan Locks you will find welcome refreshment and an exit to the main road.

Our journey was made possible by the generosity of Margaret Pratt proprietor of the “Distant Hills Guest House” in Spean Bridge (01397 712452) who left us in Glengarry and collected us at South Laggan, if you are thinking of walking the Great Glen Way be sure to make this one of your stops, I have to say it was one of the most welcoming and comfortable B&B's we have stayed in. Distance 12 Miles (19KM) approx 350m of ups and downs.

**Using a GPS on a Geotrail**

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
