The trail commences from the National Park Car Park in Grassington G/R 002/637. Use O/S Explorer Map OL2 Yorkshire Dales, Southern & Western Areas. This Walk passes through four attractive villages, Grassington being the largest and most noteworthy, In days gone by the occupants of these villages were Mill Workers, Lead Miners, and Farmers which is reflected in the local architecture, and vistas.

The walk is mainly on good paths and quiet lanes, with the exception of 160m of walking on a sometimes busy road shortly after waypoint 6, otherwise this is a walk all the family can enjoy.

Total Height Gain: 280M.          Distance: 12KM

**Using a GPS on a Geotrail**

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
