“Hadrian’s Wall from Walltown “

There is a parking and picnic area at NY 668/659 this is the place we begin our first exploration of Hadrian’s Wall, there are several sections of well preserved Wall, Lookout Towers and the remains of a Fort to create interest and fire the imagination as we following the footsteps of the Roman Legionaries. There is a good picnic area with benches half way at Cawfields, a chance for a rest before the return following the Vallum to Walltown.

We recommend you allow 4 Hours to take in the views and take in all the history that surrounds Hadrian’s Wall
Total Distance 11 KM and a Total Height Gain of 181M

Mainly on Good paths, however the path between Cawfields and Clue 5 is indistinct as it crosses fields so do a GOTO and look for the gateway by the metalled road

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
