“Langcliffe in the Yorkshire Dales “

This trail commences from the rear of the car park in the lovely village of Langcliffe (SD 823 650) Wonderful limestone scenery will escort you all the way as you follow good tracks and grassy paths, on the way you will pass over a delightful pack horse bridge, an interesting railway bridge, walk by limestone pavements with Penygent and Fountains Fell often as your companions. Refreshments are available on route at the pub about two miles into the walk, don't tarry here otherwise you will miss all the delights on offer during this visit to limestone country.

Total Distance: 13.2km (8.3 miles) with 415m (1360') of Ascent Allow 3 to 4 hours to enjoy.

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour
