“Place Fell and the lakeshore footpath “

Grade Moderate

We give you location grid references and easy questions to answer. All you have to do is walk the trail, collect all the answers and send them to peter@geotrailing.com. All correct answers qualify for an entry to our free prize draw, held every month.

Start anywhere in either Glenridding or Patterdale. Use O/S Leisure Map No 5; there is plenty to interest on this trail as we rise from Side Farm to Boredale Hause in the shadow of Place Fell, where we find Chapel in the Hause. Moving on we descend into Boredale where all is quiet, before joining the footpath that returns to Side Farm on the shores of Ullswater, be sure to stop at NY 404/190 below Kilbert How for one of the best views of the Helvellyn massif in the Lakes. Footpaths are mainly good throughout,

Distance 13.8KM, with an overall Height Gain of 542M; allow 4-5 hours to take in the views.

Using a GPS on a Geotrail

Enter your grid reference as a waypoint on your GPS, Name and save. Locate the grid reference on your map. Ask your GPS to GOTO. Remember a GPS will only give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map, use footpaths on the ground and contour.
